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## TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. All registrations must be signed and returned with full payment.
2. All heats for primary & intermediate schools will be completed on Wednesday 15 March 2017.
3. Finals for primary & intermediate schools will be completed on Wednesday 15 March 2017.
4. Prize giving will be conducted on Wednesday 15 March 2017 and recognition will be made on Saturday 18 March 2017.
5. The Turangawaewae Regatta has absolute control of the event and reserves the right to change the format of the racing where they deem necessary to ensure the needs of the event and participants are met.
6. The Waka racing co-ordinator reserve the right to cancel the race for any reason relating to the safety of participants, and where weather conditions are deemed too severe.
7. All teams provided their own steerers must ensure they are competent and experienced.
8. Teams who can not provide their own experienced steerer must indicate on their registration forms so that the officials can allocate one accordingly on the day of racing.
9. The race officials have the final decision on any dispute that may arise.
10. Schools must ensure all paddlers/ crews are wearing life jackets when they take the water
11. Support boats will be on the water at all times for immediate assistance.
12. Helpers will be in the loading bay area to assist crews in and out of the water during all races.
13. Schools must ensure any safety questions that are not outlined in this document is discussed with the Waka racing co-ordinator prior to the event.
14. Schools are permitted to erect their shade tents along the river.
15. Schools competing in the finals on Saturday will be provided a designated area to ensure the view of general public, and/or public access to the stalls are not restricted in anyway.
16. Schools must be aware that equipment will be getting set up on Wednesday 15 March 2017 in preparation for the event's main day and must ensure students are well supervised.
17. Schools/teams will be given several opportunities to train prior to the event.
