

**THE HISTORY AND THE NAMING OF SIVYER'S ROAD AT  
TINBEERWAH, COOROY, QUEENSLAND.**

My Grandfather Spencer Sivyer, was employed by the Queensland Railway Dept as an Inspector of Timbers on various Railway Constructions.

On the completion of the Cooran-Yandina link in 1891 he moved his family from Nandroya (also known as the 79 mile) to a selection at Tinbeerwah.

The portion of land was gazetted as Portion 1657, Parish of Tewanin, area 155 acres and surveyed in 1884. The Deed of Grant for this portion was granted to Spencer Sivyer on March 11 1891.

Stanley Sivyer, Spencer's son and my Father was the last member of the family to leave that area, in 1953. Because of these facts I sent a letter of request to the then Noosa Shire Council requesting the current Sivyer's Road be so named.

My request was granted by the Noosa Shire Council in a letter from them to me on April 22 1977. A photocopy of this letter is enclosed.
