

**TIMBER FOR BRIDGE OVER THE MARY RIVER, AT MARYBORO'.**

**SAWN STUFF.**

The approximate amount required is two hundred thousand (200,000) superfeet.

The sizes will average four (4) inches in thickness and six (6) inches in width.

All heart to be out of that supplied, and the timber will be restricted to iron-bark, blue and spotted gum.

All must be thoroughly free from all defects whatsoever.

Tenders to be given for delivery either side of the river, and time to be stated in which it will be supplied.

A deposit of ten (10) per cent. will be required to be deposited on amount of order given.

Payments will be made at the rate of eighty (80) per cent. on demand.

Memorandum of Agreement made and entered into this day, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy- Between S. Sivyer, of Maryborough, in the Colony of Queensland, contractor, hereinafter called the contractor, of the one part; and the Honorable Henry Edward King, Secretary for Public Works, for and on behalf of the Government of Queensland, of the other part.

Whereas the said S. Sivyer made the tender hereunto annexed, and at prices and under the stipulations in the said tender mentioned, to supply the round timber for the bridge over the Mary River, Maryborough, to be delivered at the sheds on the north bank of the river within four months from the date of the acceptance of the said tender, according to the specification hereunto annexed.

And whereas the said S. Sivyer, as required by his tender, has deposited with the Government of Queensland the sum of

thirty pounds, to be held by them as security for the due performance and fulfilment of the said tender within the time mentioned in that behalf, according to the terms and conditions of the said notice. And whereas the said tender has been duly accepted by the Government of the said Colony: Now this agreement witnesseth, that if the said S. Sivyer shall and do well and truly perform and fulfil the said tender, and the contract arising out of such tender, and the acceptance thereof as aforesaid, and all and every the terms, conditions, and stipulations thereof within the time hereinbefore in that behalf mentioned, then the said Henry Edward King, as such Secretary for Public Works, shall return to the said S. Sivyer the said sum of thirty pounds so deposited as aforesaid; otherwise he shall retain the said sum of thirty pounds or so much thereof as, in his discretion, he may think to be sufficient compensation for the non-performance of the said contract, or of any breach thereof, and that this agreement shall be a complete defence to any action by the said S. Sivyer for the said sum, or any part thereof, so to be retained as aforesaid.
