EASTER ART SHOW AND SALE 2017

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Art Show and Sale is held in the Jindabyne Memorial Hall, Kosciuszko Road Jindabyne and is open to all artists. Entries must be the original work of the Exhibitor and must be on sale for a minimum of \$50 for Adult Categories and \$10 for Youth Categories, with a maximum price of \$1,200. As hanging space may be limited, preference will be given to recent works and works that have not been displayed previously or at other venues. Should space constraints prevail, we cannot undertake to display more than five items from any individual exhibitor.

The Entry Fee is \$10.00 per exhibit for adults, \$5.00 per exhibit for youths.

Exhibits should be a maximum size of approximately 1200 mm x 900 mm and be presented ready for hanging with cord or wire on the back. Thin metal photo frame clips are not acceptable. Heavy or metal framed exhibits must have suitably strong hanging cord or wire. Exhibits not properly prepared for hanging or display may be rejected.

Each exhibit must have the following information on the back or under side of the exhibit: Artist's Name, Address, Telephone Number, Title of the Exhibit, Entry Category and Medium, and Selling Price.

Artists are asked to supply a personal resume if available so that the show attendants can answer questions from prospective buyers. Artists may also be contacted regarding their availability to "sit" for a shift as an attendant at the exhibition.

The Lions Club of Jindabyne Inc. will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits although every care will be taken while exhibits are in our custody. Entries delivered by post or courier must be securely packaged.

A commission of 25% will be charged on all sales. Artists must complete the Statement by a Supplier or ABN information on the Entry Form otherwise 46.5% withholding tax will be retained from the price of any works sold.

Exhibits should be delivered and collected only as outlined below unless other arrangements have been made with the organisers.

ENTRIES

Entry forms must be submitted with the Exhibit.. Payment may be submitted with the exhibit or direct transfer to Jindabyne Lions BSB 062655 Acct 10012726 Ref – Art Show "Artist's Name".. Exhibits must be received at 6 Kurrajong Street Jindabyne by Friday 7 April 2017 or delivered to Jindabyne Memorial Hall, Kosciuszko Road Jindabyne on **SUNDAY 9 April 2017 from 10am to 4pm.** PLEASE NOTE THAT LATE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

OPENING NIGHT

The Opening Night, Announcement of Prize Winners, and Start of the Sale will be on **THURSDAY 13 April 2017 from 7pm to 10pm.** The cost is \$15.00 per Adult and \$5.00 per Child including beverages and supper. All are welcome.

ART SHOW AND SALE

The Art Show and Sale will be open from 10am to 6pm from **FRIDAY 14 April to Monday 17 April 2017, and from 10am to 4pm from Tuesday 18 April to Saturday 22 April 2017.**

COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS

All unsold exhibits must be collected from Jindabyne Memorial Hall on **SUNDAY 23 April 2017 between 1pm and 4pm** unless other arrangements have been made. Payment for sold works will be sent to the artist after completion of the event.

PRIZES and CATEGORIES

Adult prizes totalling up to \$2500 will be awarded. A "Best in Category" will be awarded for each category attracting five or more entries. A "Best in Show (Traditional)" and a "Best in Show (Contemporary)" prize will also be awarded, plus the Lyn Ritter Memorial encouragement award for an outstanding emerging artist who has not previously won an award.

Youth prizes totalling up to \$400 will be awarded. A "Best in Category" will be awarded for each category of Painting, Drawing, Photo, Sculpture & Craft for Secondary School and for Primary School age groups.

In addition to the above, prizes totalling up to \$250 will be awarded by National Parks and Wildlife Service for artwork that reflects the "Spirit of the Snowies" across all categories.

INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, DECLARATION & TAX STATEMENT BY SUPPLIER

'Principal' means Lions Club of Jindabyne Incorporated. 'Artist' means the Artist named herein.

- The Artist appoints the Principal to display the Artists works of art and shall not hold the Principal responsible for any loss or damage whatsoever with respect to the displaying of the works of art in the Art Show.
- The Artist indemnifies the Principal and agrees to keep the Principal indemnified in respect of any claim or demand made or action commenced by any person against the Principal or for which the Principal is liable in connection with any loss or damage whatsoever suffered in connection with the Art Show, including, but without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any legal costs as between solicitor and client incurred by the Principal or for which the Principal is liable in connection therewith.
- The Principal shall not be liable in respect of any loss or damage whatsoever, whether arising in contract, tort or otherwise, sustained by the Artist or any other person which may be sustained in connection with any act or omission relating to the performance or non performance by the Principal or any of its officers, servants or agents. Such loss or damage shall include, but without limiting the generality of the foregoing, loss or damage caused by the negligence of the Principal or any of its officers, employees or agents or others, whether consequential or otherwise and whether or not such loss or damage is reasonably foreseeable. To the extent that the Principal may exclude any warranties or conditions which might otherwise be implied by any competent legislation then the Principal hereby excludes all such warranties and conditions.
- Specifically the Principal shall be indemnified with respect to all claims for loss or damage however occurred to the works of art as a result of displaying the works of art in the Art Show
