



Family Cyber Agreement for Kids

This agreement will help you to protect yourself in the cyber-world and save you from the embarrassment of not knowing enough about cyber-safety. You can fill in the dotted lines to make it specifically for you. How cool is that!

We agree that I (name, one kid per agreement),, will:

- ✓ Obey this agreement and understand that this is for my own safety
- ✓ Use technology with respect and responsibility
- ✓ Not start any new accounts, download any apps or play any online games that have an age restriction older than I and without first asking permission from my parent or trusted person
- ✓ Choose sensible screen names, user names and e-mail addresses that does not include any reference to my family, location or age
- ✓ Not share my passwords with anyone other than my parent or trusted person (even not with my friends). I understand that my parent or trusted person will not use them except if they feel that I am in danger and to protect me. I will make sure my parent or trusted person know what accounts I have, what each user, screen name, e-mail address and password is
- ✓ Understand that there are crimes online and that I can get into a lot of trouble if I misuse technology
- ✓ Use my manners and be polite when I am online; I will not swear or use mean words and I will not join in if others are being nasty; if I see cyber-bullying, I will log off and tell my parent or trusted person
- ✓ Immediately log off and tell my parent or trusted person if I see something online that is scary, mean, not nice or worries me
- ✓ Not talk to people online who I do not know in the real world (even if my friends do)
- ✓ Not post things online that I would not say in the real world



- ✓ Limit my use of technology to my 'technology times of the day'; I will log off and turn off when my time is up or if asked to
- ✓ Limit my use of technology to my 'technology money of the month'; I realise that I do not have a never-ending amount available, especially for my mobile phone
- ✓ Never agree to meet someone in the real world who I have only met online; I know that some people online are not who they say they are; I will tell my parent or trusted person if someone asks to meet me
- ✓ Tell my parent or trusted person if someone asks me to do something that I know is not right or bothers me; I will not use the webcam with people who I do not know in the real world
- ✓ Not send pictures of myself or other people without my clothes or in my underwear; I will immediately tell my parent or trusted person if I am asked to do this
- ✓ Tell my parent or trusted person if I receive rude or naked pictures of anyone
- ✓ Not share personal information online unless my parent or trusted person say it is okay; this means that I do not share my name, address, mobile and home phone number, school, sport club, teachers' name, screen names or user names
- ✓ Not open any e-mails or click links or pop-ups that are from people who I have not met in the real world
- ✓ Try to be a good and responsible cyber-user and as a family we will learn and have fun together online
- ✓ Teach my parent or trusted person as much as I can about the cyber-world as it is a lot of fun; I will help them understand things if they are unsure

My parent or trusted person will give me all the support I need to have fun and stay safe in the cyber-word with an agreed amount of time and money.
