- 1 cup plain flour
- 1/2 cup buckwheat flour (see note)
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 cup reduced-fat milk
- 2 eggs
- 1 tablespoon brown sugar
- 1 medium red apple, peeled, coarsely grated
- Olive oil cooking spray
- Vanilla yoghurt, to serve

METHOD**Step 1**

Sift flours, baking powder and cinnamon into a bowl.
Add milk, eggs, sugar and apple. Stir to combine.
Cover with plastic wrap. Refrigerate for 30 minutes.

Step 2

Lightly spray a non-stick frying pan with oil.
Heat over medium heat. Using tablespoons of batter at a time, cook pikelets, in batches, for 1 to 2 minutes or until small bubbles form on surface. Turn. Cook for 1 to 2 minutes or until golden and cooked through.

Transfer to a wire rack to cool.

Serve with yoghurt.

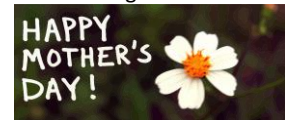

Throughout the last month our Grasshoppers have been super busy. We celebrated Easter by engaging in creative arts, story books, conversation, cooking experience, imaginative and role play. The Easter Bunny even came to Cuddle Bugs and left some special little treats around our front yard. We then moved onto Anzac Day by discussions about why we have a day off for Anzac Day and read a story book called "My Grandad marches on Anzac Day". Rosemary and Grevillea plants were added to red play dough with poppy placemats as symbolic meaning and engagements of Anzac Day.

We extended this interest by reading The Very Hungry Caterpillar, engaging in an interactive felt story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar, making our own lifecycle then watching a very detailed lifecycle documentary on the iPad.
