Robbie our singles champion

Robbie "Nursery" Rimes has regained the mantle as Toowong singles champion, albeit in unfortunate circumstances.

Gary Andrews has been forced to forfeit the final because of a crippling knee problem which also ruined his chances in the fours final.

Robbie, singles champion in 2011-12, reached the final with a 25-15 semi-final win over Scott Gregory last Saturday which was in the balance at 13-all.

But Robbie showed his class by restricting last year's finalist Scott to only two more single shots.

Doug Pannell and Chris Hassen completed an outstanding pairs-fours double, teaming with Ward Kenny and David Falkenmire for a 28-11 defeat of Tim Salway, Peter Jordan, Jim Adams and Gary Andrews.

But Andrews was hampered by his knee problem and had to be replaced after 13 ends by substitute Des Denino, with Jim Adams moving to skip.

Pinpoint leading by Kenny and some great shot-making by Hassen at third featured in Pannell's win, while Peter played some great bowls in a losing side.

Alicja and Pam – our Ladies Pairs Champions

The much anticipated match for the Ladies Pairs Championships for 2016, between the team of Pauline Bishop and Harriet Posner vs Alicja Malicka and Pam Salway did not disappoint on Saturday.

It was a tussle all the way, but good leading by Pauline, and Harriet's support with some good skip shots, saw them leading at the midway point of the match. But a loss of 5 on one end upset the apple-cart, allowing Alicja and Pam to draw level, and regain momentum. Both Alicja and Pam

played solidly and consistently throughout the match, and once they had their heads, held the lead through to the end, winning 21:17.

In the **ladies singles semi final** played earlier in the day on Saturday, Gayleen Trevaskis proved to be a force to be reckoned with. After a shaky start, she honed her deadly backhand, fighting back strongly after Pam Salway held a 10 point lead. Pam, playing consistently held on to win 25:19. - *Help with the putting away of equipment each bowls day.*
- *Make sure the absentee book is up to date*
- *Roll-up etiquette – when the club is open, let the bar staff know you're there & ask where is best to roll up.*
