

ANOTHER HAT-TRICK

Please note :

- Refers to Consistency only - If you are unable to play on the day the game is called, BEFORE the “called” day please make alternative scheduling arrangements to play the game. The game should be played at a time convenient to both players/teams. Games should be played within 1 week of the “called” day. Consistency Rules

Singles

The object of the game is to draw as close to the jack as possible and score points as follows: 4 points for the closest bowl, 3 points for the next closest, 2 points for the next and 1 point for the fourth closest.

The first player to score 100 points wins the game.

During play, should a player kill an end or send the jack into the ditch, that player is penalized by 10 points.

During play, should a player's bowl move the jack more than 1 meter (as determined by the measuring stick) from its original placement, (as determined by the 'washer') , that player is penalized by 5 points.

The toss of a coin decides who shall play first, thereafter the player winning the 4 points (closest bowl to the jack) takes the mat and rolls the jack. The jack is placed on a 'washer' to establish it's placement throughout that end of play.

Equipment required :

- 1 Jack
- 1 Washer
- 1 measuring stick = 1 metre
- 1 person to mark
