

## Terriers qualify for final

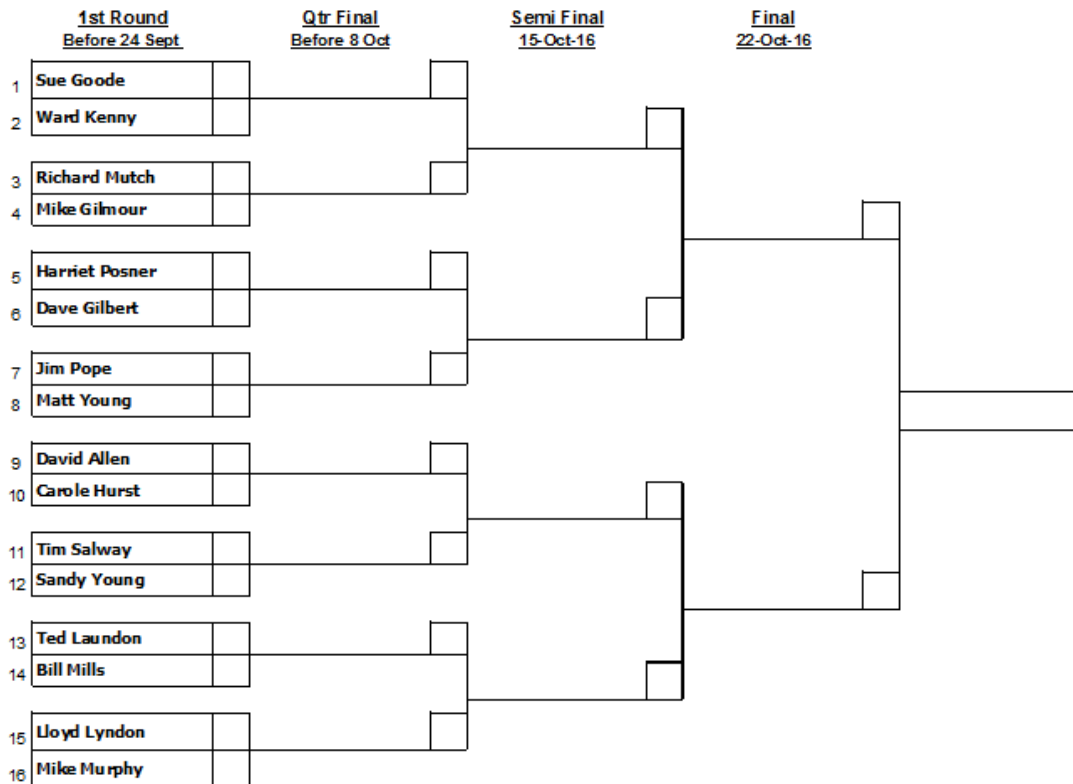
