MEN'S SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIPS

Arrowsmith fires for second singles title

Warm favourite John Arrowsmith bagged his second singles title at Toowong and moved a step closer to a clean sweep of Champion of Champions events.

Club captain John, who beat a gallant Alistair McKay 25-18 in the final, has already won the fours and is one of the favourites for the pairs with "Tiny Jim" Adams.

Although John was always in control of the final, it was 14 ends each over 28 ends and Alistair kept hanging in there by picking up ones.

John led 17-8 and threatened to win easily but Al grabbed three ends on the trot to cut the margin to 17-14.

The favourite again slipped away to 22-14 before Al picked up three ones in a row to keep the contest alive.

A winner of the singles at his first attempt in 2014 after moving from Sydney, beating Robbie Rimes, John is clearly a top-class bowler.

He will tackle the Australian Open pairs and fours events at the Gold Coast next week, playing third for former state player Andrew Waddell in the fours.

It was not a happy week for Alistair who also tasted defeat in the first round of the pairs.

Paired with the affable Matt Young, it was one way traffic as they raced to 11-0 and 12-1 over sub-sub Tony Dobinson and a rattled David Falkenmire.

David Allen and Peter Jordan overcame strong early resistance from Doug Buchbach and Tim Salway for a 24-17 win. It was 11-all at one stage.

Les Chamberlain and Peter Longland advanced with a 21-18 defeat of David Gilbert and Steve Hossack who paid the penalty for dropping two sixes.
