A comfortable 69-55 home win over ladder leaders Red Hill has kept our Div 5 team's finals hopes alive.

Toowong are in third place on 12 points behind Red Hill (14) and Ferny Grove (13), who oppose each other in the last round on Saturday.

It means Toowong must beat Everton Park-Stafford at Everton Park and rely on Red Hill winning at home to figure in the final.
