This has progressed to the stage where an agreement has been signed by the two clubs for the 2018 men's pennant season.

The Terms of Agreement are:

- 1 The joint team will be known as New Farm-Toowong (NFT)
- 2 The team will nominate in Divisions 1, 2, 4 and 5.
- 3 Divisions 1 and 4 will play out of New Farm.
- 4 Divisions 2 and 5 will play out of Toowong.
- 5 Two selectors will be appointed from each club. There will be no quotas of how many players in a particular division will participate from each club.
- 7 The clubs will co-operate to design a new playing shirt and agree on uniform matters.
- 8 The Agreement will be in operation for the 2-18 pennant season.
- 9 There will be an annual review.
