Junior State Championships

Girls lost by 32 to 2 approximately. Molly played very well and had 5 or 6 touchers. I think Amelia was loosing focus a bit although her driving was getting better. Would have won more than 2 ends but Amelia knocked Molly's shot bowl out twice and the girls didn't have a lot of luck.

Premier Sevens

Three wins from four attempts was a more than acceptable weekend return for the Toowong Terriers.
