

Sixes provide winning relief

THE pain of another narrow Div 1 loss, 59-63 to Windsor, was given some relief with Div 6's 66-46 romp over Gaythorne. But at 0/3 and up against titleholders Indooroopilly this weekend, the Div 1s desperately need a win.
