

### 6ers sew up final berth

A 40-shot win at the weekend was a fairly emphatic way for Toowong to cement a place in the Division 6 pennant final going into the last round this Saturday.

Our Division 1 team almost pulled off the upset of the season in a last end thriller against reigning champions Indooroopilly.

The 6ers chalked up their sixth win from seven matches 79-39 to remain on top of the ladder and are assured of at least second place going into Saturday's home match against St Lucia.

Dashing Des Denino continued his unbeaten five-match run skipping Des Baglin, Ted Laundon and Murdoch McDonald to a 31-11 landslide, Peter Longland's team of Col Gray, Peter Jordan and Ben Longland continued their good form 26-12, and Jim Adams was full of praise for his team of Peter Speare, Jim Pope and Brian Vandersee in a 22-16 win.

The 1s, although without star pair John Arrowsmith and Chris Hassen, were pipped 56-54 by Indooroopilly in a gutsy display.

Jeff Twist led the way with a five-shot win (21-16), supported by Val Scolaro, sub-sub Chris Thomson and Piotr Malicki, while Rob Rimes went down fighting (17-19) and Keith Donaldson fell 16-21.

It now means the 1s must beat St Lucia at St Lucia on Saturday to be sure of retaining their top division status and they will be hungry to make amends for the shock loss to our neighbours in the first round.
