

SEEDED STARS ELIMINATED

TWO seeded players, Alistair McKay and Piotr Malicki, bit the dust in men's singles championship play last Saturday.

McKay, the 2001 champion, was the victim of a stunning 25-8 win by Val Scolaro, who holds the rare distinction of winning the Toowong C, B and A singles titles in the one year early in his career. Policeman Val, who earlier beat Des Denino 25-13, is the first player through to the semi-finals and he will be hard to beat for the title.

Malicki fell 25-22 to draw specialist Lloyd Lyndon in an upset result, but Lloyd can never be discounted.

Titleholder John Arrowsmith and fellow equal favourite Rob Rimes both progressed to the quarter-finals but both were extended. John saw off Chris Thomson 25-18 and Robbie held Peter Longland at bay 25-19. Des Baglin downed Ben Longland 25-8 and is a dark horse for the title on his best form.

In pairs championship matches, Arrowsmith and Malicki beat Lyndon and Mike Gilmour 22-17, and Rimes/Baglin defeated Doug Buchbach and John McConnachy 26-13.
