

## **Val regains title after long gap**

A remarkable 22 years after he won the title as a first-year bowler, Val Scolaro is the Toowong singles champion again.

After accounting for titleholder John Arrowsmith in a semi-final, Scolaro's vast experience told as he disposed of Scott Gregory 25-10 in the final.

Scott's great run to the final, with Chris Hassen and Robbie Rimes among his scalps, looked set to continue when he raced to an 8-0 lead in the final.

But Val quickly settled into a rhythm and scored the next 18 unanswered shots against a bewildered Scott who has proved himself a prize new acquisition for the club.

The good news for Toowong is that both players are available and looking forward to playing in our top division pennant team.

The pairs final also proved something of an anti-climax, with Piotr Malicki and John Arrowsmith going back to back in beating Chris Hassen and Doug Pannell 29-12.

Chris and Doug had earlier down Jim Pope and Peter Jordan 22-9 in a contest that was closer than the score reflected.

But they were unable to contain the reigning champions, with Arrowsmith in particular pulling off some big shots.
