

Terriers bolstered for pennants

PENNANT season has arrived and brings with it high hopes for Toowong in Divisions 1 and 4, but especially the top division.

The team has been strengthened by the acquisition of Gary Andrews, Scott Gregory and Alan Keighley, plus the availability of singles champion Val Scolaro.

Andrews is a vastly experienced bowler who played a major role in the birth of Premier League in 2000 when he was a member of Springwood. Gary has more recently played out of Salisbury where he was outstanding in Premier Sevens O60 singles.

His close friendship with club manager Jim Adams has brought him to Toowong and we are delighted to have him as a Terrier. Gary has been chosen as third for John Arrowsmith.

Scott Gregory has come from Norfolk Island and is a very talented young bowler who quickly made his presence felt by reaching the singles final. He will play second for Arrowsmith in the opener against New Farm at New Farm.

Alan Keighley, who was our only representative in the Brisbane team for the State Sides, is a top-class player lining up for his first pennant season with Toowong after representing the club in Premier Sevens this season.

Val Scolaro is a highly versatile bowler who can play anywhere from skip to lead. But he has expressed the wish to play lead and the selectors have acceded to his wishes by placing him up front for former state skip Jeff Twist.

Jim Adams has also forced his way into the side as lead for Arrowsmith after playing third and skip for Toowong's winning Division 6 team last season.

Three rink losses in a trial against St Lucia last Saturday was far from encouraging but Twist, Scolaro and star skip Robbie Rimes were missing.

Toowong's team is undoubtedly capable of challenging for the pennant if it performs to its full potential.

A 2-1 trial win at home against St Lucia was a promising start for the Division 4 team which should be able to handle the elevation from Div 6.

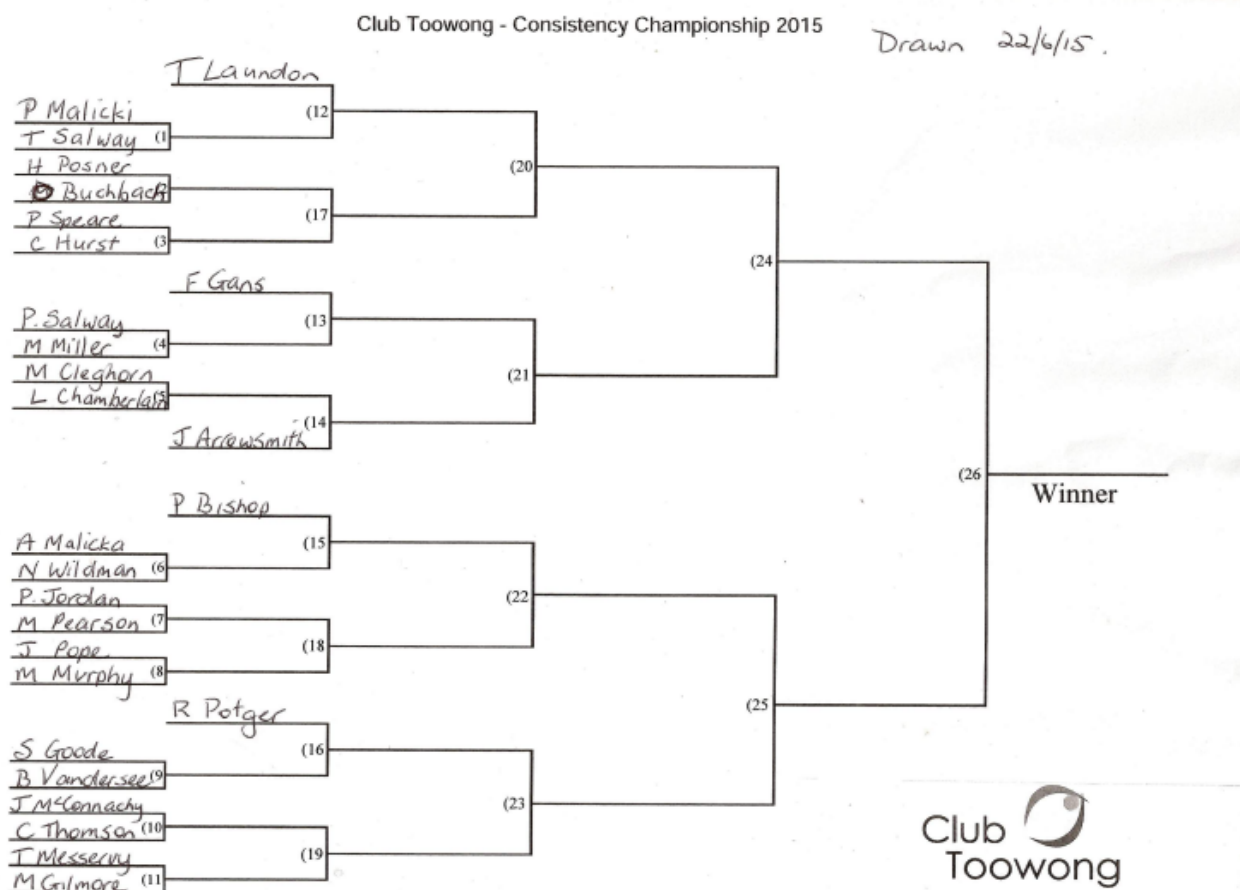
