

MENS SATURDAY PENNANTS

Div 1 pressure mounts

A four-shot loss with two rink wins, 54-50, at Windsor has placed Toowong's Division 1 status on a knife's edge.

With only two wins, Toowong shares bottom of the ladder with Everton Park on four points but is placed fifth on shots for and against.

A home win against New Farm on Saturday would relieve the pressure before a last-round clash at Everton Park.

In Div 4 at Ferny Grove, Toowong lost (62-56) by the same margin, six shots, as in the first round. David Falkenmire's rink led throughout for a 19-18 win, Alistair McKay finished strongly for a one-shot loss (17-18) and Lloyd Lyndon's team fought bravely in a 26-20 loss.
