## CLUB NEWS

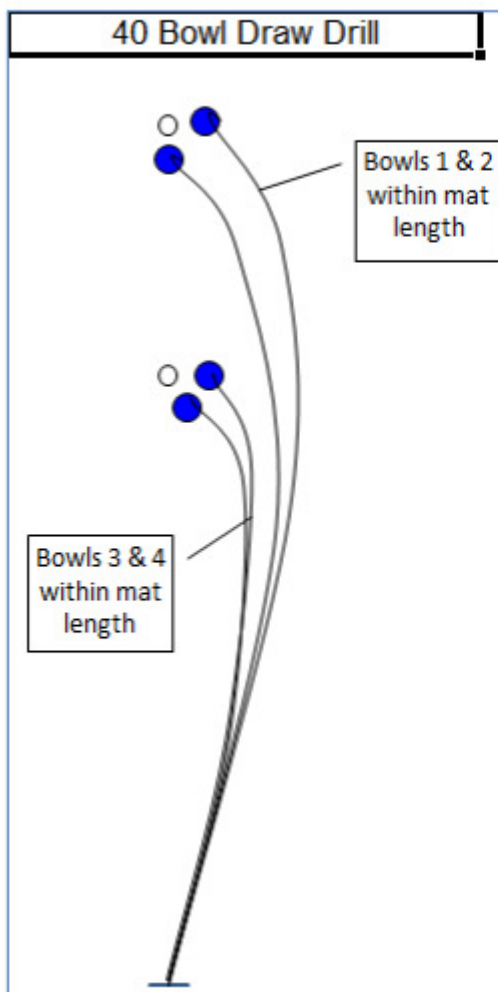

### Etiquette.....
