TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE 2018 SINGLETON ART PRIZE: A PAINTING AND DRAWING SHOW

Artists are reminded of issues associated with originality, copyright and plagiarism.

A. Eligibility

1. Artists may have two paintings per section.
2. If submitting two works in any section, the artist must prioritise them in the "Hanging Preference" column on the entry form. If entry numbers exceed hanging capacity the organisers will exclude second priority works in the most numerous sections until hanging capacity is reached.
3. No individual exhibit may be entered in more than one section.
4. All paintings entered are for sale. *The Rotary Club of Singleton on Hunter will retain 25% of the sale price.*
5. Each entry must be suitably framed, with secure cord or wire attached. Frames or hanging devices requiring repair work will be rejected.
6. Bare stretched canvas must be painted around ALL the edges, if not it MUST be framed.
7. Except in the Miniature section, the maximum size of any work including frame is 1350 mm x 1050 mm and must not exceed 6kg in weight.
8. Miniature section, maximum size is 100 cm² of art work area and the frame a maximum of 30 cm x 30 cm.
9. Entries in Section H must be by artists residing in the Singleton LGA (Local Government area).
10. Works with three dimensional embellishments will not be accepted except in section C-Contemporary.
11. Work that is ceramic, pottery, sculpture and copies of original work, will not be accepted.
12. Triptych and diptych painting configurations will not be accepted.
13. Other types of art such as prints and photographs will not be accepted.

B. Entries

1. Incorrect entries will not be exhibited and entry fees will NOT be refunded.
2. Incorrectly completed or incomplete entry forms may not be followed up and may lead to disqualification.
3. Payment must be received with or prior to submission of entry form.
4. **Closing date for receipt of entry forms is Friday 29th June 2018. Late entries will NOT be accepted.**
5. All entry forms require an email address unless alternative arrangements are approved.

C. Delivery and return

1. All works must be **dry** on delivery.
2. A completed information label must be fixed to the back of the work, see [page 8](#).
3. The artist's name and address must be clearly marked on the outside wrapping for return post/transport.
4. Hand delivered & couriered paintings are to be delivered to the Singleton Civic Centre between 9am & 3pm (up to 6pm with prior arrangement) on Tuesday 24th and Wednesday 25th July 2018.
5. Posted entries must be addressed to: PO BOX 348 SINGLETON NSW 2330, and arrive no later than Wednesday morning 25th July and cost of return post included with work if applicable.
6. All transport and insurance costs are to be met by the artist. Late arrivals will not be hung.
7. Collection of sold and unsold works from Civic Centre will occur between 9.00 am and 6.00 pm Wednesday 1st August. No exceptions can be made as we have no ability to store uncollected work.
8. It is the artist's responsibility to enclose a **return** consignment note with the art work, when work is being returned by commercial couriers, such as TNT, Star Tack, Fast Way, DHL, etc.

D. At the Exhibition

1. The committee reserves the right to hang works at their discretion.
2. Paintings moved or relocated by the public or artists may be disqualified.
3. The greatest possible care will be taken, but no liability will be accepted for damage or loss during the Art Prize and while in the care or transport of the organisers.

E. Judging

1. The judge's decision will be final. The judge may decide not to award a prize in any section.
2. One work will be acquired for the Singleton Art Collection, so all prize winners are potentially acquisitive.

Frequently Asked Questions- These FAQs form part of the terms and condition of entry

How old can an artwork be at the date of entry?

Art work must be no older than two years and must be the work of the submitting artist.

Are there any restrictions on entries for the Contemporary section?

Artists wishing to submit works in the Contemporary Section C should remember that the Singleton Art Prize is a Painting and Drawing event. In this section, artists may use any medium of their choice and have three dimensional embellishments but the works must otherwise fit the measurements specified in the eligibility criteria and must not constitute a safety hazard to handlers and viewers.

Should I keep a copy of my entry form?

Yes. We recommend keeping a copy of all entries posted/emailed for your records.

How is GST treated?

Artists who regard their painting as a hobby must declare no GST is charged or applicable.

Artists who paint as a business must declare their ABN and whether or not they are registered for GST. If registered, GST must be included in the price of the painting.

Why do you request my email address and bank details?

Email addresses are required to notify payment from the sale of art works and prize money.

BSB and Account number OR PayID are required for payment of sale proceeds and prize money.

What happens if my artwork isn't collected by the required time?

Any works not collected by 6.00 pm Wednesday 1st August will be posted COD back to the artist, including those belonging to residents of Singleton LGA.

Can I nominate some-one to drop off and pick up my artwork?

If artists do not collect their own works, they are required to provide authorisation for their delegate to do so with their entry form.

Can my artwork be photographed?

NO photographs are to be taken including by phones & tablets without the approval of the organisers.

The organisers have the right to have any entry photographed & reproduced in the press, internet, social media or telecast for publicity purposes for this and any future Art Prize. Copyright will reside solely with the artist.

How will notified if I've won a prize?

All winners will be notified by phone, text or email as soon as the judge advises the organisers.

ALL prize winners are expected to collect their prize on Opening Night Friday 27th July at 7.45 pm. If they cannot attend they are asked to nominate a proxy to accept their prize. If that is not possible, the organisers will nominate an alternate.

How do I enter?

Please complete the entry form in full by typing the information into the required fields. Then print and sign the acknowledgment. Please then either transfer your entry fee or include payment with your form.

You can then either scan and email the entry form to artprize@singletononhunterrotary.org.au or post to "The Singleton Art Prize" PO Box 348, Singleton NSW 2330. Postal entries MUST be received by Friday 29th June 2018.

Please ensure you allow adequate time for postal entries.

Entry fees are \$12 per work and \$6 per work for the Youth sections I, J and K.

Courier Arrangements

The Singleton Art Prize organisers have again engaged local company, Taxico Logistics, to provide art courier services from Sydney and the Central Coast, having successfully transferred over 1000 art works since 2012 for the Art Prize. Taxico Logistics have over 20 years' experience transporting sensitive equipment and instruments. Two Rotarians from the organising committee accompany the works, thus ensuring professional handling procedures.

Pick-up and Return of Artwork

The following drop off and pick up locations are available with Taxico this year:

These businesses have all very kindly offered to be a depot where entries for the Singleton Art Prize can be delivered prior to the show and collected when works are returned after the show.

Works must be at the pickup points by close of business Monday 23rd July.

The Taxico pickup date will be AM Tuesday 24th July and the return date 2nd August.

Courier Fees and Payment

The courier fee is \$75 for up to three works of art and a further \$25 per painting for each additional painting.

The fee structure and method of payment will be either paid up front with the entry form OR an envelope showing the artist's name, number of works and contact details containing the transport fee (either a cheque or print confirmation of electronic payment) attached to the exterior of the packaging of the art works. This fee will cover collection from the depots listed above, delivery to Singleton and return delivery to the same pick up depot. There is no surcharge for large paintings.

Payments must be made prior to the pickup date by either direct deposit or cheque enclosed.

The closing date for receipt of entry forms is Friday 29th June. Couriered works enclosing an entry form will not be accepted. **Entry forms must be posted and received by the above date.**
