Conditions & Definitions

- Points are collected for 1 horse / 1 owner for the pointscore year, with the owner to be a current subscription holder of the County of Cumberland ASH Branch.
- Points for the High Point Youth Horse are to be collected for a horse & rider combination from youth events only. Youth events are not included for the open horse pointscores.
- Points are to be received by the pointscorer by 31 August 2018. You will receive a confirmation email of the receipt of these points. If you do not receive this, please follow up your nomination.
- A separate performance sheet is to be completed for each horse & each section entry.
- Junior Horse - Horses 3 years & under for the competition year
- Senior Horse – Horses 4 years & over for the competition year
- Versatility events include Dressage, Campdraft, Station Horse & Utility events.
- Points will be counted from the open events (Novice and/or other restricted events are not counted)
- Points will be awarded as follows: 1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point, Champion = 2 points, Reserve Champion = 1 point, Supreme = 1 point
