We were fortunate enough to host two branch clinics so far this financial year, both attended by more than 20 members.

ASH Accredited Coach Teena Bridge & Claire Mourant shared their knowledge and experience at our clinic at Londonderry Pony Club in June. With a focus on getting the horses travelling forward and riders riding actively & accurately, it was exciting to see the progress made by all combinations over the course of the weekend. We had a combination of both youth and adults, while a great time, and lots of hard work, was had by all. We are planning to host another clinic with Teena later this year, with more details to be released soon.

September saw our campdraft clinic with ASH Accredited Coach David Wilson, held at the Camden Bicentennial Park. Despite the wet & boggy conditions, all riders had an opportunity work cattle in the camp and then to have a go outside while avoiding the mud puddles! Before starting on cattle work, all participants worked on accuracy and getting the basics right, with a follow-up session the next day to see the improvement. Throughout the weekend riders practiced getting in the right position with the beast, blocking up in the yard & getting the beast around the course. A big thank you goes to John Adams (Adams Livestock Transport) for the use of his cattle, Danny & Kylie Mannix for organising everything and to everybody who helped out over the weekend.
