- **Rehearsal** will be on the **Friday 2 March 2018** at Wayville Show Grounds. Please make sure all or majority of the participants are available for rehearsal. Times will be arranged with you closer to the date.
- Artistes are required to use costumes appropriate to their style of dance
- It is understood that performances and participation by individuals and groups is undertaken on a voluntary basis and no remuneration is offered. However, we shall provide the following for each registered performer (and their registered legal guardian if the performer is under the age of 18):
 1. Complimentary Standard Entry pass to the event
 2. Complimentary car park for performer aged over 18 or guardian
 3. Complimentary snack voucher to the value of \$10
 4. Complimentary water refreshment
- Recognition of individual performances by individual name, group performances by group name will be made at the event and within the circulated Running Sheet.
- Your performance segment and timing will be notified closer to the event date and is subject to change. You will NOT be promised a particular segment time and the IAASA MELA COMMITTEE's decision in this regard will be the final.
