2019 MCDONALDS AUSTRALIAN BILLY CART CHAMPIONSHIPS RACE FORMAT

Registrations and scrutineering is located at 163 Sanger Street (outside of Hotel Australia).

Entries close at 9:30 am sharp on the day (cash and Eftpos only).

Drivers must pick up their cart number and wristbands prior to the first race.

The cart number must be clearly displayed on the billy cart or the driver's helmet.

Driver and pit crew must wear wristband at all times during the event.

All billy carts and drivers must attend for scrutineering between 0900 and 1000 All drivers are strongly urged to attend the scrutineering area as early as possible to avoid last minute queue resulting in missing your event.

Drivers Briefing 1000 - 1015

Officials are empowered to judge the driver's condition and ability to drive. Officials are further empowered to disqualify any driver displaying poor sportsmanship.

QUALIFYING: 1030 - 1200

Each entry will receive 2 qualifying runs. In the event of a timing malfunction extra runs will be held so each entrant records 2 qualifying times, time permitting. Lane selection for qualifying will be randomly assigned. In the event of a tie the average from both qualifying runs will determine position. If still tied a coin toss will be used.

LANE SELECTION: 1200 – 1215 (officials lunch break)

The fastest 4 carts in each category (based on fastest qualifying time) will run in the final. Lane selection based on qualifying times. In the event of a tied fastest times second fastest time used to decide position. Finalists to report to recording desk to nominate lane before 1215

FINALS: 1215 to completion

Winners of each final will be presented their trophy and prize directly after their race. All drivers are to remain with their cart until the formalities are over. In the event of a tie equal position will be awarded.

RACE FORMAT

1. Racing commences at 10:30 am.
2. Entrants are organised into age classes with qualifying and finals run in the following order:
 - 9 Years and Under (3 entrants per race)
 - 10 to 13 Years
 - Celebrity Challenge
 - 14 to 17 Years
 - 60 Plus
 - Open Class (18 Years and Over)
 - All Schools Challenge
3. All Schools Challenge is open to all primary or secondary schools. The driver can nominate one school that he/she will represent. Winners of the All School Challenge agree to display the perpetual trophy at their school for the duration of one year. The winner must return the trophy at the next Australian Billy Cart Championship event.
4. Winners of each age category will receive a trophy and \$100 prize money. A trophy will be presented to 2nd and 3rd. The winner of the All Schools Challenge will receive a \$100 target voucher.
