Tyrrell's Wines



Rich in history and pioneering achievements since 1858.

Established in 1858 by English immigrant Edward Tyrrell, Tyrrell's Wines is one of Australia's pre-eminent family owned wine companies with vineyards extending from their historic home in the Hunter Valley.

Headed up by fourth generation family member Bruce Tyrrell, Tyrrell's is home to some of Australia's most awarded wines including the iconic Vat 1 Semillon. Since 1971, Tyrrell's has been awarded over 5,000 trophies and medals and in 2010 was named "Winery of the Year" in James Halliday's Australian Wine Companion. With the fifth generation, Chris, Jane and John, involved in the business, Tyrrell's will continue to remain family owned with the simple philosophy of producing high quality wine that people love to drink.

Lindeman's Wines



Lindeman's is anchored in the acclaimed Hunter Valley wine region under the Australian sun. The Hunter Valley has been the home of Lindeman's since its establishment in 1843. Lindeman's Ben Ean Cellar Door is a key attraction, welcoming more than 100,000 visitors every year. Guests are able to enjoy the complete Lindeman's experience, in a picturesque setting, with beautiful grounds framed by undulating vineyards, rolling hills and a palpable sense of history. The Lindeman's Ben Ean Cellar Door is also home to the Still Room, housing amazing treasures from Lindeman's 170-year history. The vineyards surrounding the Ben Ean Cellar Door are home to Semillon, Tempranillo and Shiraz.

The Silos Estate



The property encompassing Silos Estate was established by John Wiley (a Scot) in 1870 who bought the land and began the farming of the property nearly 150 years ago. For a lengthy period of time the property was a dairy, and many of the old farm buildings form part of the current estate operations today. Since 1984 the property has changed hands several times, with various owners restoring the buildings, planting the vineyard and establishing the restaurant and cellar door.

Your hosts – Sophie and Rajarshi – have been at the property since 2007. Since then the property has found a new lease of life with the accommodation having been further developed and upgraded, the winery and cellar door expanded and new labels for the winery released. A near picture perfect vista now greets all visitors.

Cambewarra Estate



The Cambewarra Estate vineyard was planted on 20 acres of dairy land. With the magnificent Cambewarra mountain as a backdrop, 12 acres of vineyard have been planted. Planted are Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, the exciting new variety Chamboucin, and Verdelho, winner of the Boutique Wine Trophy. The rolling hills of the Shoalhaven Valley surround the two acres of dams which irrigate the vines. Hand picking, the optimum northerly aspect and good drainage ensure that the final product is of the best quality. The wines of Cambewarra Estate, like the distinctive region in which they are produced, have an elegance and identity that are widely recognized.

This is highlighted in their Chamboucin, which won a bronze medal in its first vintage in 1994 and has continued to accumulate many gold, silver and bronze medals in significant wine shows. Cambewarra Estate won the first gold medal awarded in Australia for their Chamboucin Port (at Cowra in 1998), and they have also won a national trophy for their Cabernet Sauvignon.

Two Figs Winery



Two Figs Winery sits proudly at the top of one of Mount Coolangatta's Foothills overlooking the Shoalhaven River and offer a simply breathtaking view of the river and beyond. Two Figs Vineyard was planted in 2003. The Winery is now producing wines including Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Chamboucin and Verdelho. Also sample some local produce during the wine tasting amidst the equipment and barrels of this working winery. The climate is temperate with maritime influences and produces soft approachable wines. Recently voted Best Small Cellar Door Shoalhaven Coast - Australia's Best Cellar Door Awards 2015.

Coolangatta Estate



The history of Coolangatta Estate stretches back to the early 19th Century. It was in 1822, that partners Alexander Berry and Edward Wollstonecraft settled on the foothills of a mountain named Coolangatta, after obtaining a grant of 10,000 acres and 100 convicts from the NSW Government. The date 23 June 1822 has since been recognized as the first European settlement on the South Coast of NSW. Alive with history, the original convict-built village is now surrounded by sprawling vineyards and landscaped grounds. With Multiple Gold Medal Winning Wines & recently Best Wine of the Competition at the Prestigious Sydney International Wine Competition makes Coolangatta Estate a must for any discerning wine connoisseur.

Mountain Ridge Wines



Mountain Ridge Wines is set on a 75 acre working farm which produces beef, macadamia nuts, limes & free range eggs. The vineyard was planted in 2007. Grapes are handpicked, produced and bottled on the property by the family with traditional winemaking practices. Working towards sustainability Mountain Ridge Wines generates a large amount of their energy needs on solar panels. The winery employs traditional winemaking practices and all the wines are processed on the property.

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
