#### **PATCHWORK QUILTING**

55. Patchwork Quilt made from recycled clothing - Front & Back (except batting). No less than 120cm x 150cm

#### **CREATIVE NEEDLEWORK**

*Soldiers recuperating in hospitals during WW1 were given boxes filled with beads, fabric, ribbons etc & heart shaped pattern measuring 20cm in width. These 'Sweetheart Pin Cushions' were then sent back to the soldiers families by the Red Cross.*

56. Make a 'Sweetheart Pin Cushion', approx 20cm wide , dedicated to someone past or present



#### **KNITTING**

*To stop 'rogue knitting' of socks that might be ill fitting or not well made, the Australian Soldier's Sock Fund' printed a book in 1915, called 'The Grey Sock Book' to help knit the perfect sock. More than a million pairs of socks were knitted by Australians during WW1.*

57. Knit a pair of Adult size socks, any design or colour

#### **EMBROIDERY**

*Embroidered postcards from WW1 are known as 'silks'. They were hand embroidered strips of silk, made by French & Belgian women, often with 'patriotic themes & forget-me-nots'. The finished embroidery was mounted on postcards. They were hugely popular with the soldiers, sent home as treasured mementos.*

58. Embroider a 'silk' postcard with a design influenced by the artwork of May Gibbs (Gumnut Baby Stories).  
Postcard must measure approx 10cm x 15cm



#### **SEWING**

*When WW1 started, it was uncommon for women to have jobs, apart from domestic serving roles. This was the beginning of many changes for women*

59. Recycle , repurpose & embellish , with unbounded creativity, a mens suit jacket into women's wear.
