a) ANNETTE KELLERMAN (1886 - 1975)

Australian Swimmer, Vaudeville Star, Actress, Creator of Synchronised Swimming, Creator of one-piece bathing costume, business owner

b) SIR HUDSON FYSH (1895 - 1974)

Australian Aviator. Served as a Lieutenant in Australian Light Horse Brigade & the Australian Flying Corps in WW1. Founder of QANTAS

c) HELENA RUBINSTEIN (1872 - 1965)

Cosmetician, Business woman, Philanthropist, Art Collector
Emigrating in 1902 from Poland, she began her business in Melbourne.

d) WILLIAM LAWRENCE BRAGG (1890 - 1971)

Australian Physicist. Joint winner in 1915 with his father, William Henry Bragg, of the Nobel Prize in Physics for *x-ray diffraction*, an important step in the development of X-ray crystallography.

e) VIDA GOLDSTEIN (1869 - 1949)

Australian Feminist & Suffragette, Newspaper Editor & Owner, Pacifist & Founder of the Women's Peace Army in 1915.

f) JAMES FRANCIS "FRANK" HURLEY (1885 - 1962)

Australian Photographer, Adventurer, went to Antarctic in 1911 with Douglas Mawson & Ernest Shackleton's Imperial Trans-Antarctic Expedition in 1914.
