SPECIAL CLASSES

Animals entered in Special Classes must also be entered in their age class.

10. Sire's Progeny – 2 goats, of either sex, by the same sire, from different dams. Sire to be named.
11. Dam and one progeny
12. Breeders Group – 3 goats, of either sex, to be bred by the exhibitor.

COMMERCIAL CLASSES

Judging Criteria – A commercial animal is that of a lesser qualities of a Stud animal but displays good meat production in a commercial production herd.

A score of 1-5 could be given for body confirmation and meat qualities.
