Vendor Declarations must accompany entry forms

HEALTH REGULATIONS FOR SHOWING DAIRY GOATS

For Caprine Arthritis Encephalitis - C.A.E. and for

Johne's Disease - J.D.

- 1 Goats must be from Certified or Accredited Herds or alternatively the following applies:
All Goats over 12 months of age to have 2 negative tests in the previous 12 months, approximately 6 months apart.
- 2 Kids 6 to 12 months to have one negative test.
- 3 Kids under 6 months to be from a negative sire and dam - Certificates to be produced.
- 4 Goats must not have been in contact with positive or untested goats and must not have been exhibited at any show that does not require goats to have been tested negative for C.A.E.V. during previous 12 months.
Please sign a statement to this effect.
- 5 Certificates to state names and tattoos of goats tested negative.
- 6 ALL goats must be from herds that have had at least one negative blood test for JOHNE'S DISEASE. A Herd Test means ALL goats on the exhibitors property, regardless of breed, over 6 months of age must be tested at the same time. The entry must be accompanied by this declaration, fully completed and signed by the exhibitor and a veterinary practitioner.
- 7 A Veterinarian Certificate identifying all goats by tattoo numbers showing a negative result to Johne's Disease, must also be presented with entries.

REGULATIONS

1. All exhibitors must be members of the Dairy Goat Society of Australia.
2. All exhibitors must abide by the current DGSSA Inc Show and Health Rules.
3. Health Certificates must be sent in with entries
4. Please state name of exhibit, identification and date of birth on entry form.

13. Dam and Daughter, both in milk. same breed
14. Doe with best udder, First Lactation.
15. Doe with best udder, Second or Subsequent Lactation.

29. Owner bred kid under 12 months, unkidded
30. Dam and Unkidded Daughter, same breed
31. Breeders Group of three Does, same breed, milker and two juniors (preferably goatling and kid). Two juniors to bear owner's prefix.
