



Junior Player Code of Conduct

Meningie Football Club as part of its management plan requires all junior players and their parents, caregivers and supporters to be informed and made aware of the club code of conduct including responsibilities and expectations. This document is a summary of the MFC Policy Manual which outlines club operating procedures and is available on request.

- **Behaviour** - Sportsmanship and respect of team mates, officials, umpires, supporters and opposition players is to be displayed at all times. Swearing and abusive behaviour will not be tolerated at any time. Respect to the club, officials, fellow team mates and members must be displayed at all times when using social media.
- **Club Membership** - Subs are to be paid in full by or at the first game of the season. Club insurance is only available if payment has been received.
- **Supervision** – Coaching staff have a responsibility of care for junior payers during training and match times only. The club takes no responsibility for anything that occurs outside of these supervised times.
- **Picking up and dropping children off** – The club will ensure that there is someone there 5 minutes prior to training beginning, however we ask that parents/carers are aware of the time that training finishes and that they are there on time to collect children. In the event that they are going to be late, please phone your coach.
- **Club Support** – Players and parents/caregivers are expected to contribute if asked to help out with boundary umpiring, goal umpiring and timekeeping. Other jobs may include assisting at the canteen, score board or running water.
- **Police Checks** – All club coaches, trainers, runners and team managers are required to have completed a police check form
- **Junior Committee** – All concerns, issues or opinions are to be reported to a Meningie Football Club Junior Committee Member; details are provided in the Member Handbook.
