These surveys were conducted on the telephone by trained interviewers among voters throughout Australia. Telephone numbers and the person within the household were selected at random. The data have been weighted to reflect the population distribution of enrolled voters at the close of rolls. The survey was conducted on July 1-2, 2016 and is based on 500 interviews among voters. The maximum margin of sampling error is plus or minus 4.4 percentage points.
